- Parade: 2:00 – 2:45 Students will report back to their homeroom class after the parade to get ready for dismissal.
- Check Outs: 2:45 – 3:00 Teachers will have a sign-out sheet for check outs in their homeroom class. All students checking out must be signed out on their teacher's sheet.
- Dismissal: 3:15 – 3:40 Students who are not signed out by a parent will go through regular carpool/bus/extended day dismissal procedures.
- Reception: 2:45 – 4:45 Mrs. Burkhalter's retirement reception will be held in the gym immediately following the parade. All students who are checked out by a parent are invited to attend.
