They are done designing and shopping for fabric. They are busy, busy, busy....trying to put on all the embellishments and get ready for fittings. The Make-Up and Costume Design team have to create a minimum of 20 character designs. We have publicity working scripts and slideshow which means are almost ready for the show!

Did You Know?

- ◆ More phone calls are made on Mother's Day than any other day of the year.
- ◆ Anna Jarvis was the founder and conceived of Mother's Day as a way of honoring the sacrifices mothers made for their children.
- ◆ Mother's Day is celebrated throughout the world, traditions vary depending on the country. In Thailand, for example, Mother's Day is always celebrated in August on the birthday of the current queen. In Ethiopia, families gather each fall to sing songs and eat a large feast as part of a celebration honoring motherhood.
- ◆ In 1914 President Woodrow Wilson signed a measure officially establishing the second Sunday in May as Mother's Day.
- ◆ 133 million cards are exchanged annually, according to Hallmark, making it the third-largest card-sending holiday in the U.S.
