

GET READY FOR 2ND GRADE!

These are skills from your grade level this school year to practice this summer. BRCVPA Students are expected to have these skills on the first day of school next year.

MATH

- Add and subtract within 20 fluently
- Represent 10s and 1s in multiple ways
- Order and compare numbers up to 120
- Understand place value for ones and tens
- Tell time on an analog (face) clock to the hour and the half hour
- Measure using non-standard units (paperclips, shoes, spoons, etc)
- Add value of coins within 50 cents
- Recognize 2-dimensional shapes and 3-dimensional figures
- Divide shapes into equal parts (halves, quarters)
- Create and read picture graphs

ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

- Identify the characters, setting, plot, and main ideas of a story
- Write a paragraph using complete sentences
- Read and spell common sight words and simple unknown words using spelling patterns
- Retell a story in sequence using important details and by finding information in a text
- Use capitalization and punctuation correctly when writing.
- Speaking in complete sentences

science

- Plan and conduct simple investigations
- Recognize and predict cause and effect
- Understand sound moves in waves that can vibrate objects
- Understand the impact of light on objects and mirrors
- Understand the basic structure and function of plant and animal parts.
- Recognize that traits vary from parent to child
- Recognize patterns of movement in sun, moon, and stars
- Recognize seasonal patterns

SOCIAL STUDIES

- Construct personal timelines
- Identify important American people, landmarks, and symbols
- Identify basic landforms on a map
- Use cardinal directions
- Recognize relationships between environment and shelter
- Appreciate the environment's impact on food and clothing
- Recognize human impact on environment
- Identify your home city and state
- Distinguish wants vs. needs
- Distinguish goods vs. services

Physical Education

- Master ALL locomotor skills independently (skip, run, hop, etc)
- Master stepping in opposition to throw
- Practice rolling accuracy from a low or medium level

- Practice dribbling on dominant and non-dominant hands
- Master kicking a stationary ball with accuracy
- Practice planting supporting leg when kicking

- Follow rules and procedures in different environments
- Describe opinions and thoughts
- Follow 3-step directions
